In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of all previous rules on the subject, the Governor of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely.—

1. Title, ¹[commencement and application].—(i) These rules may be called the **Karnataka Education Department Services (Department of Public Instruction) (Recruitment) Rules, 1967.**

(ii) In respect of each category of posts specified in column (2) of the Schedule, the methods of recruitment and the Minimum qualifications, and the period of probation, if any, shall be as specified in the corresponding entries in columns (3) and (4) of the said Schedule.

General Note.—

1. In respect of the posts in the Educational Institutions the age limit is relaxed upto 40 years in the case of physically handicapped persons *i.e.*, those who are blind, deaf, dumb or having physical deformity of legs and hands, provided they possess the requisite qualifications.
2. Any inclusion of a new post or a change in the number of posts or pay thereof, even if finally agreed to by Government and notified, shall not come into effect automatically unless the concerned Department makes out a case separately and obtains the sanction of Government with the concurrence of the Finance Department.
3. Any revision of the scale of pay that may be agreed to by Government in the manner indicated in 2, above shall come into operation only on the change of a incumbent of the office. It shall not automatically reduce or enhance the pay of the existing incumbent according to whether the scale of the post is lowered or enhanced. In other words, it does not give such an incumbent the right to claim the enhanced scale of pay, though the post may have been shown as upgraded in the "Cadre Notification" of the particular service.
4. In the case of a candidate belonging to the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe, who fails to pass the examinations or tests required to be passed within the prescribed period of probation, the period of probation shall stand extended by such period as may be necessary to pass the departmental examinations or tests provided that such period shall not extend beyond the period in which the results of two consecutive departmental examinations or tests are announced.

(2) All the posts, other than Graduate Assistant Masters and Assistant Mistresses in Government Higher Secondary Schools and Multipurpose High Schools, included under Column 2 shall be filled up by transfer of Graduate Assistant masters and Assistant Mistresses in Government High Schools, Higher Secondary Schools and Multipurpose High Schools who have not less than five years of teaching experience as trained graduates."

(iii) in Column 4, in the entries under sub-heading "Essential" under the heading 'For direct recruitment', the words (Science) shall be *omitted*;
