NOTIFICATION-I

The draft of the Karnataka Public Employment (Reservation in Appointment for Hyderabad-Karnataka Region) (Organization of Local Cadres, Allotment and Transfer of Persons) Rules, 2013 which the Government of Karnataka propose to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-para (1) of Para 4 and Sub-para (1) of Para 5 of the Karnataka Public Employment (Reservation in Appointment for Hyderabad-Karnataka Region) Order, 2013 is hereby published for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration after 15 days from the date of its publication in the official Gazette.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received by the State Government from any person in respect of the said draft before the expiry of the period specified above will be considered by the State Government. The objections or suggestions may be addressed to the Principal Secretary to Government, DPAR, Vidhana Soudha, Bangalore-560 001.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-para (1) of para 4 and Sub-para (1) of para 5 of the Karnataka Public Employment (Reservation in Appointment for Hyderabad-Karnataka Region) order, 2013, the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following Rules, namely:-

RULES

**CHAPTER-I
PRELIMINARY**

1. Title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Public Employment (Reservation in appointment for Hyderabad-Karnataka Region) (Organization of Local Cadres, Allotment and Transfer of Persons) Rules, 2013.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their Publication in the official Gazette.

2. Definitions.- In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-

- (a) "Cadre Controlling Authority" means, the Secretary to Government or the appointing authority of the concerned Department as the case may be who shall be the Authority for the purpose of sub para (1) of para 4 of the order;
- (b) "Jurisdiction of a Cadre" means the jurisdictional area of the appointing authority of a cadre or the Jurisdictional area or unit of seniority of a local cadre;
- (c) "Order" means "the Karnataka Public Employment (Reservation in Appointment for Hyderabad-Karnataka Region) Order, 2013";
- (d) "Parent Cadre" means any existing cadre out of which local cadre or part of a local cadre is made or carved out;
- (e) "Residual Parent Cadre" means the cadre with posts which are not identified as local cadres and continue to be remaining in the Parent Cadre.

**CHAPTER-II
GENERAL**

3. Organization of Local cadres.- (1) Pursuant to Paragraph 3 and 13 of the order, the Cadre Controlling Authority may identify by notification the number of posts in each cadre within the jurisdiction of the cadre constituting local cadre in the manner specified below. The posts identified and constituted as local

shall be reserved for local persons in accordance with the respective rules of recruitment for promotion or direct recruitment as the case may be.

(2) The manner of constituting a Local Cadre which may consist of following units, namely:-

- (a) "State level local cadre" means a cadre carved out of respective Group A (upto Junior scale), Group B, C or D posts in the State level offices or institutions in Government or body or organization to the extent of 8% as Local Cadre.
- (b) "Regional Local Cadre" means a cadre carved out of total number of posts in the region equal to 75% in Group A (upto Junior scale) or B posts or 80 % in Group C posts or 85% in Group D posts in the region in the respective cadres of State Government or body or organization. This also includes cadres having jurisdiction of the cadre District wise, Taluk wise or with smaller jurisdiction of the respective Appointing Authority, within the region.
- (c) "State wide Local Cadre" means the Local Cadre constituted by merger of State level Local Cadre and Regional Local Cadre where the jurisdiction of the cadre is of State wide in State Government or body or organization.

(3) The Cadre Controlling Authority shall ascertain the total number of posts in the state level offices or institutions or in a body or organization and identify by notification and constitute state level local cadres to the extent required to be reserved under rule 2(a) above.

(4) Where jurisdiction of a cadre is District wise or Taluk wise or a Unit less than the said jurisdiction, Local Cadres shall be constituted within the jurisdiction of the cadre separately.

(5) Where jurisdiction of a cadre is State wide, the cadre controlling authority may merge State level local cadre with the regional local cadre by notification and constitute a single State wide local cadre in Government or in a body or organization.

(6) For the purpose of reckoning adequate representation of local persons in a local cadre, existing representation of local persons in the local cadre shall be taken into consideration.

CHAPTER III

4. Operation of Roster for the purpose of Reservation.-

(1) The Residual Parent Cadre and the Local Cadre carved out of it, shall be treated as separate unit for the purpose of recruitment, appointment, seniority, promotion and for operation of reservation. Two parallel roster cycles shall be operated for the residual parent cadre and the local cadre.

(2) All the available posts of a local cadre may be assigned appropriate roster points as per the existing reservation rules and guidelines.

5. Notifying the local cadre with Roster.- (1) A local cadre with assigned roster points shall be notified by the Cadre Controlling Authority so that available posts initially may be filled by allotment by the local person.

(2) The Cadre Controlling Authority may issue a certificate of home town in the form specified in Annexure-A as local person to the existing employees after verifying the home town or place as in the service register.

(3) Where an employee claims for a place other than that entered in Service register, he shall obtain eligibility certificate in the form specified in Annexure-B from the Competent Authority that he belongs to the category of local person.

Note.- the purpose of this rule Competent Authority means the Assistant Commissioner of the Revenue Sub-division who shall be competent to issue the eligibility certificate.

CHAPTER - IV

Allotment of persons to a Local Cadre

6. Application for local cadre post.- (1) The Cadre Controlling Authority after having formed and notified the local cadre with roster points shall call for the option through a general circular, from the existing employees satisfying the criteria of local person and who are willing to join the cadre, to exercise their option within 30 days in the format specified in Annexure-C. In case of eligible employees who do not exercise their option within 30 days it shall be deemed that they are not interested in joining a local cadre.

(2) The Cadre Controlling Authority may to the extent of available posts in the local cadre and based on the seniority in the parent cadre and after following roster as applicable to the individual applicant may either accept and allot the applicant to the local cadre or reject the application.

CHAPTER-V

Seniority and Related Issues

7. Seniority and Related issues: (1) The Competent Authority shall maintain separate seniority, in each local cadre and Residuary Parent Cadre.

(2) While initial allotment of incumbents to the local cadre, is as per roster and the seniority the interse seniority as in the original gradation list of the parent cadre shall be maintained in the new Gradation List of the local cadre.

(3) Seniority of the remaining incumbents in the Residual Parent Cadre shall also be as per their relative seniority in the original

(4) The Cadre Controlling Authority shall also maintain a joint seniority list in the original parent cadre.

CHAPTER - VI

8. Shifting of Non Local Person from a Local Cadre.-

Wherever a non local person is occupying a local cadre post, such non local person shall be shifted to the Residual Parent cadre for cadre control purposes. Provided, such non local person may continue to occupy such post in a local cadre as a Deputationist.

CHAPTER-VII

Miscellaneous

9. Roster imbalance in the local cadre or in the Residual parent cadre due to the bifurcation of a cadre.- Roster imbalance due to allotment of individuals from the parent cadre to one or more local cadres and in the Residual Parent Cadre, shall be ascertained by

the authority and be made good in the subsequent Direct Recruitment or Promotion, as the case may be, as per the rules of recruitment applicable to the cadre

10. Saving Clause: The Government may from time to time issue necessary clarification in the matters of interpretation of the provisions of the order or these rules.
